Using SMART goals helps you break down your goals into smaller

sections so you can see specifically what steps you need to take to successfully achieve your goal. I am currently using the SMART goal with my BTAS program. My goal is to obtain my

I am taking it step by step though with making sure my goal is specific (Bachelor's degree), measurable (track my classes), achievable (staying dedicated and on the right course with classes), relevant (in line with what I want for my future and my Associate's), and time-bound (given timeline until May 2023). Watching those short or even long term goals is important. The goals seem to be more appealing and obtainable when you have small boxes to check off, instead of a few large tasks to complete in a short amount of time.

Some of the leadership skills that my chosen career might entail, is having that strong sense of leadership, decision-making and determined personality. Being a business owner takes a lot of self discipline, determination and motivation. Being aware of how to learn those skills or to naturally have them is important. Along with the strong leadership skills, you also have to know how to be empathetic towards your clients. Show them that you're here for them and being able to allow yourself to show and have emotions towards and with your clients takes patience.
